Health and Safety

Fire prevention - A fire alarm system is installed as per the Ministry of Civil Defence regulations with a current certificate. Fire evacuation practice is held EACH term and is included in the children's curriculum planning. Parents are required to "sign in and sign out" daily for their child.

Sign in and sign out - All parents will be required to sign in and sign out for their child on a daily basis - for use in fire evacuation purposes.

A fully equipped clinic-with medical equipment provided as mandated by the Health Authority of Abu Dhabi (HAAD)

A GP Doctor visits our clinic monthly on a Tuesday - available for advice on a range of medical issues. Our Clinic Nurse is also responsible for both kitchen and housekeeping staff

Infection Control - THE NURSERY IMPLEMENTS INFECTION PREVENTION AMONG CHILDREN IN THE NURSERY. PARENTS SIGN THE MEDICAL REDIRECTIVE FOR. AS STATED IN THE MEDICAL FORM:

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR US TO MINIMIZE THE SPREAD OF PREVENTABLE ILLNESS IN CHILDREN AT OUR NURSERY. WE THEREFORE ADVISE ALL PARENTS TO REFRAIN FROM BRINGING YOUR CHILD TO NURSERY IF THEY ARE SUFFERING FROM THE FOLLOWING SYMPTOMS:

DIARRHEA VOMITING FEVER SYMPTOMS OF FLU OR EXCESS COUGHING

YOUR CHILD MUST BE SYMPTOM FREE FOR 24-48 HOURS BEFORE YOU MAY BRING YOUR CHILD BACK TO NURSERY.

FOR COMMUNICABLE CASES, A DOCTOR'S CLEARANCE IS REQUIRED TO BE SUBMITTED IN THE CLINIC UPON RETURN TO THE NURSERY. IT IS A NOTE/REPORT FROM THE DOCTOR THAT STATES THAT THE CHILD'S CONDITION IS NO LONGER CONTAGIOUS AND IS SAFE TO RETURN TO THE NURSERY. IF YOUR CHILD DEVELOPS FEVER OR ANY SERIOUS INJURY/ILLNESS WHILE IN THE NURSERY, YOU WILL BE CONTACTED IMMEDIATELY TO COLLECT THEM.

CCTV - are in all rooms, hallways, garden and entrance area - viewed by the Director and Human Resource for Health and Safety

Complete medical information must be provided by the parents, in order for the staff to be aware of any child's medical condition, food allergies and other important information related to health or development. A picture of the child with their specific allergies are laminated and placed in the Kitchen and playroom/classroom to ensure that safety of the child is not put in jeopardy at any given time.

Full staff team - Teachers and Learning Support Assistants (LSA's) pictures and child care qualifications are posted on our website. The House of Colours Nursery has 100% QUALIFIED CHILD CARE STAFF Annual academic calendar - Term time dates and holiday dates is uploaded for 2018/2019 Subject to change dependent on Abu Dhabi Education and Knowledge (ADEK) the called public holidays Terms and conditions - Dates for advance fee payments. Term time fee prices are available from the

Uniforms with Nursery logo (Not required for the baby and toddler wing - 2 months to 2 years!)

Available to purchase from the office staff during the first week of term

Choice of 6 colour t- shirts - Orange, Red, Green, Yellow, Apple Green and Purple Skort or short - Navy Blue

Hat - for sun safety - Choice of colours - Pink or Blue. Mandatory for all children using our garden. The staff will use 1 passport photo of your child, which they will laminate and attach to the back of the hat so the child can easily find their own hat.

Shoes - A strict shoe policy will be enforced - for health and safety reasons Closed shoes only please - No crocs, flip flops or football trainers allowed

Two teaching books - Available to purchase from the office staff

- 1. Nursery rhyme song book 200 songs used to teach in all rooms
- 2. Jolly phonics letter sounds book used for teaching from 3 years old upwards

Parent letters - any important letters/notes will be sent to the classroom - where parents will have to sign as having received them

Floor Supervisors and Key Person responsibilities

Floor Supervisors - are experienced Teachers holding a Child Care qualification who also work in the classrooms with the KEY PERSON and are available to talk to parents on a range of Nursery related issues Key persons are just that - the KEY PERSON who is specifically assigned to get to know your child to gain a bond with them - PLEASE GET TO KNOW YOUR KEY PERSON AND FLOOR SUPERVISOR Settling in observations - Sent to parents after 6 weeks in the Nursery. Detailed observations of your baby/toddler/young child from Teachers/Learning Support Assistants, Floor Supervisors and Director Parent/team evenings - These evenings are by appointment only and parents will be given dates in advance to book a 20 minute informal chat about their child's development. One meeting organised per term.

All babies and toddlers in Baby Blooms and Poppy playrooms have the following recorded for parents to see daily. Drinking, eating, sleeping and pampers changes.

General information

Settling in your child - Separation anxiety information is available

Key persons - A KEY PERSON is allocated for EVERY Babies, toddler and young child in the Nursery Bookings - Parents can choose the times to book their child into the Nursery - either 07.00am to 14.00pm or 07.00am to 17.00pm (and can change their times too)

Extra care - This is available from 14.00pm to 17,00pm with clear terms and conditions - charged at 10aed per half hour for any time after 14.00pm. Please see our accountant for full details

Birthdays - Please see your Floor Supervisor for party arrangements

Storage - Cupboards will be labeled with a picture and your child's name to safely store any pampers or changes of clothes required for the week ahead. Chairs will be also be labeled with the matching picture.

Toilet training - This is done in partnership with the staff and parents - Information will be sent out to you by the Floor Supervisors

Employee of the month - Praise for the staff!

Behavioural issues - Biting and other behavioural issues do happen in any Nursery - We have information and help for you to manage this in partnership with the Nursery

Parents - How can you help?

Below are details of a few essentials your baby, toddler and child will need DAILY pampers and changes of clothes

Milk bottles (ready made up and named - the staff will explain to you our policy)

Individual containers with food stuffs (named)

Baby towels - your baby may need a bath whilst with us

Clear policies are in place for safe sleep, changing diapers, use of pacifiers, cleaning equipment and toys

Education - Learning through play

Playrooms and classrooms - Ages and stages appropriate curriculum and equipment Curriculum - Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

Daily Routines - Each class follows a clear routine for all play (Includes garden, music and central area), sleeping and eating times. The Floor Supervisors can print a copy for you on your request

Circle times - children share their personal experiences (Hello songs, days of the week, counting the children, Introduce the themed topic of the week and or the special event, Review and new Jolly phonic letter sounds and song of the week)

Free play - children play with different toys of their choice

Arts - children encourage to channel their creativity with planned art and craft activities

Music - The children go daily to music room (musical sessions, story book with CD, Educational DVD and puppet shows)

Garden - Gross Motor skills (Large body muscles) children enjoy outdoor play with sand, water, climbing equipment, balls hoops, cars parachute and obstacle courses

Pre-writing skills - Fine Motor skills (Small hand muscles) Lots of activities are planned and resources are provided to help the children to develop their future writing skills

Story times - children enjoy story time with puppets, audio visual and dramatisation

Mathematics - children learn pre- number concepts through activities and audio I visual aids (differentiation activities)

Simple science - Life cycles and how plants grow

Central free play area - (Upstairs) Provided for social role play - Home corner, community workers, (Police, Firemen etc.) play shop, hospital and hairdresser.

Parent information boards - Located and displayed for all age groups in all the main wing hallways - with clear information on the following

Bus outings - Carrefour shopping mall and bakery, Zoo and park (Teddy bear's picnic) These trips are planned for the attending children upstairs who are 3 years and above and must be out of pampers. Subject to ADEK approval.

Children with Special Educational Needs (Now called "Children of Determination") are accepted on a case by case basis and we provide an Individualised Educational Plan (IEP) and Individualised Care Plan (ICP) to ensure that their extra needs are being addressed. Specific goals are set each term and will serve as guides for the whole teaching team, Nurse, Floor supervisor, Director as well as the parents of the child.

Learning Journals - Each child will receive a Learning Journal (LJ) This is a file to track their development and learning while attending the Nursery. Each week the staff will place an art work that the child has done AND a weekly photo is taken with a descriptor linked to the 17 Early Learning Goals (ELG's) (see separate attachment). Parents can view their child's LJ at the planned parent Teacher evenings. The LJ follows the child to the next class for the next Teacher to continue and can be taken home when the child finally leaves the Nursery.
